

Regular.

Town Hall, Mt. Pleasant, S.C., Aug. 4, 1902

A Regular Meeting of Town Council was held this evening at 8 o'clock.

Present: ~~J. Hartzell, Intendant,~~ Wardens Coleman, Hamlin, Jorgensen, Mitchell and Pincken. In the absence of the Intendant, Warden Hamlin occupied the chair.

The minutes of the meetings held on ~~August~~ July 7th, 8th, 15th and 16th were read and confirmed.

A bill of E. Pincken for \$54<sup>00</sup> was ordered to be paid.

Town Election.

Messrs. J. R. Tomlinson, A. M. Pincken, and W. P. Worsham were unanimously elected the Board of Managers of the Town Election for Intendant and Wardens to be held on August 20th next.

Vaults.

Warden Coleman, Chairman of the Health Committee, reported that Mr. R. S. Vanning had undertaken the cleaning of vaults in the town.

The Ways and Means Committee reported a license of Two Dollars (\$2.00) on selling Ice alone.

Commons Lot.

On motion of Warden Jorgensen, the Committee on the Sale of Commons Lots was authorized to sell to Isaac Kinlock Lot # for \$80.00 Eighty Dollars.

Warden Pincken stated that Mr. Schaffer's safe could be purchased for \$50.00. Warden Pincken, Chairman of the Committee on Accounts, and the Clerk were appointed a Committee to see the safe and determine upon its suitability.

Town Books.

On Warden Pincken's motion, the Clerk was instructed to inform the Solicitor that the Minute Book, Ordinance Book, and other property of the Town now in the hands of Mr. J. H. Bryan, must be returned to the Hall by next Thursday.

Warden Pincken asked continuance for his Bill relating to the Town Treasurer's Bond. It was granted.

Jail Lot.

The Treasurer stated that there was a purchaser for the Jail lot if it was secured by the Town. Warden Mitchell thereupon moved that Warden Smith be appointed a Committee to go to Monck's Corner and see the Supervisor of Berkeley County in regard to the purchase of that County's interest by the Town.
