At Regular Mid Monthly meeting of
held by Council April 18-1904. There were
present Intendant R. T. Royall Wardens
Walters, Jorgensen, Coleman, and Dienker.

Minutes of meeting of April 4th
was read and confirmed.

Warden Hamlin reported that after
consulting the members of the Charity Committee
they had decided that it was necessary
to furnish food and a nurse to attend
the Peirce family, Tom Peirce especially
being in a helpless condition.

On motion of Warden Jorgensen duly
seconded Warden Walters bill to amend the
Sunday was taken up and passed its
first reading.

Warden Walters requested that his
bill be taken up for its 2nd reading.

On motion of Warden Hamlin duly
seconded Warden Walters request was granted
by a unanimous vote, and passed its
second reading.

Warden Hamlin gave notice that he
would offer a bill at the next meeting
to amend ~~the~~ the Liquor Law,
prohibiting the sale of Liquor in the Town
of Mt Pleasant.

Warden Walters gave notice that he
would introduce a bill for the collection
of Licenses and Taxes at next regular
meeting in May.

There being no further business
meeting was adjourned.
