At Special meeting of Town Council
~~held~~ present held Jan 23rd - 1905.
 for the consideration of better fitting
 the Town with Fire protection, there
 were present, Intendant R. Royall
 Wardens E. Tiencken, A. B. Kugler, W. D.
 Hamlin, and A. S. Walters.

Warden Kugler Chairman of Fire
 Committee recommended for said committee
 that the Town purchase One Chemical
 Engine similar to No. 8, Champion, one
 30 feet Extension Ladder, one 20 feet
 Ladder, two 12 feet Ladders, that a
 sufficient number of Buckets be bought
 to make a total of 36 counting those
 now owned by the Town, One Gong
 or Bell placed about 20 or 30 feet
 from the ground, Two Axes and
 Six Fire Hooks, also one Wagon for
 Hooks Ladders & Co.

Moved by Warden Hamlin that the
 report of Fire Committee be adopted, and
 they be instructed to carry out the provision
 of said recommendation, after a full
 discussion same was put to a vote and
 carried unanimously.

On motion of Warden Tiencken
 The Town Treasurer was authorized
 to Borrow \$1000 - said amount to be
 paid in July 1905 from collection of
 Taxes and Licenses.

There being no further business
 meeting was adjourned
