Warden Tiencken chairman reported that he had received two (2) lighters of shells and began putting same down on the streets.

Intendant Royall reported that J. D. McCrary Co had sent an Engineer here, who had gone over the Town, but wished more time for making plans, for better proof of the water supply, he advocating that the Artesian Well be blown out to ascertain the ^{full} capacity under pressure.

On Motion of Warden Tiencken the Intendant with Warden Crouch was given the authority to get the material and make the test required by the McCrary Co with old Artesian Well for the purpose of finding the best water bearing levels. Meeting was then adjourned
