Mount Pleasant S. C. November 1914

A. Regular Meeting of Town Council was held Nov. 16, 1914
 Present Hon. W. A. King Mayor Aldermen King, Kelly, Cassard, Tiencken
 and Crouch. Alderman Donaldson absent.

Minutes of last Regular Meeting were read and confirmed.
 Communication from Charleston Div. of Palms Traction Co. in relation to
 Hydrants, quoting \$45. a year rental for each Hydrant was read.
 Alderman Crouch was requested to obtain further information, and a
 quotation on 15 to 27 Hydrants.

The Street Committee reported that a survey of Eight Hours Alley had
 been made by the Town Surveyor, and that they had tried to see the
 Town Solicitor, but found him ill and unable to attend to business.
 Mr. Tiencken was told that whenever desired, The Solicitor would send
 notice to have the fence removed.

Alderman Crouch complained of the water during heavy rains, flowing
 across White Street, and flooding his lot.

Mr. Crouch as Chairman of the Fire Department and Drainage Committee
 was requested to formulate a plan for the Drainage of White Street
 at the point complained of, and report at next meeting of Council.

The following bills were approved and ordered paid.
