Petition signed by several of the young
 citizens of the town asking that Council

 grounds for a court, to be erected by and at
 the expense of petitioners

 coming municipal election

Motion of Alderman Weinheimer duly seconded
 by Alderman Eckman was adopted by
 unanimous vote of Council to raise the
 salary of Chief of Police J. J. Boyd from \$85.00
 to \$100.00 per month

 for the fiscal year commencing June 1st 1926
 and ending June 30th 1927 was passed to its
 first and second readings
