Regular meeting of Council held this evening

The treasurer report showing a balance of \$3656.76  
was received as information

By the unanimous vote of Council  
Aldermen Finnegan and Donaldson were  
elected to look into the fitness and merits  
of the Evinrude fire engine and if same  
is found to work satisfactorily are authorized  
to purchase one, with the necessary  
equipment.

Upon the call of the Mayor for the reading of  
the applications for the positions of Chief  
and Assistant of Police there being only  
one applicant for each office the Clerk was  
instructed to cast the unanimous vote  
of Council for the applicants J. J. Boyd  
as Chief of Police and Edmund Jenkins as  
Assistant

There being only one applicant for the  
position of Clerk and Treasurer J. J. Boyd  
was unanimously elected to that position.

Alderman J. J. Finnegan being duly nominated  
was unanimously elected Mayor pro tem  
There being no applicants for the positions  
of Chimney Contractor and Cemetery inspectors  
(White and Colored) the positions were left vacant
