to investigate the cost of having the tablet made and the wording to be placed on it. Mayor Eckman was elected Chairman of the Committee and appointed Aldermen Weston, Siencken and Dardy to serve with him-

Mr. Weston reported to Council that the Auditorium did not have proper ~~locks for the doors~~ and latches for the windows. It was agreed by Council that the necessary locks and latches should be purchased and installed.

Mr. Jerek reported that the jail was not in a sanitary condition and that no provision had been made for the necessary comfort of the prisoners. Mr. Weston made a motion seconded by Mr. Siencken that the Marshall take care of the matter.

Mr. Weston brought to the attention of Council the large amount of unpaid taxes and urged that Marshall make a special effort to collect all that he could.

The clerk was instructed to write Mr. J. R. Mahoney Mgr of the Southern Ice Co. and advise him that it would be necessary for his company to take out an additional license before they could engage in the coal business in Mt. Pleasant. The cost of which would be 10<sup>00</sup> additional.

The clerk was instructed to write a letter to Capt. J. A. Guilds - Chairman of the Waterworks Comm. suggesting that in view of the present clerk of Council being also Manager of the Waterworks that the office of the Commission be transferred to the Town Hall.

Council requested the Mayor to take up with the Town's attorney the laws necessary to enable the Waterworks Commission to secure additional customers-

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned-
