A regular Meeting of Town Council was held this evening with the following Members present: Mayor W. L. Crookman, Alderman Weston, Smith, Melchers, Trampton, Royall and Diencker.

On Motion of Alderman Weston seconded by Alderman Melchers Council voted unanimously to accept the bid of the Chicago Pump Co. to furnish two Sewer Pumps equipped with 3 H.P. Motors for 1190.00 or with 5 H.P. Motors at 10% additional as outlined in their letter of Oct 23 1941 to the John M^cGrady Co.

On Motion of Alderman Weston seconded by Alderman Diencker Council authorized the John M^cGrady Co. to purchase on letter bids from local dealers a truck load of pipe in order to be able to start work.

On Motion of Alderman Melchers seconded by Alderman Diencker Council appointed Alderman Weston purchasing agent for small quantities and incidental materials for construction of the Sewer System. The Clerk was instructed to advise the John M^cGrady Co. at this appointment.

On Motion of Alderman Weston seconded by Alderman Diencker Council instructed Mr. Peares to advise the John M^cGrady Co. that Council would agree to increase their engineering fee from 6511.00 to 7554 provided sufficient funds were available at completion of the job. and if not to adjust his fee between the two amounts.

There being no further business Council was adjourned.
