A Special Meeting of Town Council was held this evening with the following members present. Mayor W. L. Eckmann, Aldermen Weston, Melchers, Trampton, Smith, Sieneken and Keyall.

Alderman Melchers advised Council that the Sewer Connection for his property had been placed too high, necessitating him to have his bath room connections raised and part of the pipe from his bath room to the street exposed. Alderman Weston made a motion which was seconded by Alderman Trampton and passed that the Town furnish Mr. Melchers sufficient sand to cover his pipe safely.

Capt. Thoma O. Weht complained to Council that the connection to his property on Mary St. known as Rose's Place was too high and therefore he would be unable to connect this property to the Sewer System. Capt. Weht ^{advised} that there was no connection for his vacant lot on Mary Street and requested that a connection be installed for him as he wished to connect his property on Hehken St at this point. Capt. Weht also requested that an additional connection be placed for Mrs. Everette's property as the present one was not in the correct place. Council requested Mr. Robertson, Engineer for the W. P. A. to have the two connections made and on motion of Alderman Weston seconded by Alderman Melchers agreed to assume responsibility for any changes that may be requested in the future.

Letters from Mrs. R. W. Crouch and from Mr. H. Taylor in regard to the necessity of cleaning up lots in their Section of Town were referred to the Town Marshal for his attention on motion of Alderman Weston seconded by Alderman Melchers.

Mr. E. M. ~~Keyall~~ ^{Keyall} requested the use of Alhambra Hall for the Boy Scouts and also requested that they be given a key to the Hall. This matter was referred to the Hall Committee.

There being no further business Council was adjourned.
