A Special meeting of Town Council was held this evening with the following members present. Mayor. W. H. Erickman Aldermen. Weston, Smith, Melchers, Traupman, and Freeman.

Mayor Erickman advised Town Council that the meeting had been called to discuss the delay in construction of the Sewer System. and steps to be taken to improve the situation.

Mr. McGrady, Mr. Heywood and Mr. Bradley of the John McGrady Co. were present and advised Council that laborers were being allowed to loaf on the job and that lack of proper supervision was holding up the job.

On motion of Alderman Weston seconded by Alderman Melchers, Council instructed the Clerk to write Mr. E. L. Burton - Area Superintendent for the W. P. A. and advise him that the job was not progressing as rapidly as possible due to labor loafing on the job and to request a thorough investigation. The Clerk was instructed to send copies of the above letter to Mr. E. P. Grice - Field Representative and Mr. W. F. R. Johnson. Area Supt for the W. P. A.

On motion of Alderman Weston seconded by Alderman Smith Council instructed the Clerk to advise the John McGrady Co. that Council had received notice from the County Board of Health and the U. S. Health Dept that the storm drain on Terry Street should be put back in operation immediately, as in its present condition it was causing a health menace. and to request the John McGrady Co. to arrange with the W. P. A. to have this storm drain repaired as soon as possible.

The Clerk was instructed to get a price on the property of the Estate of Lee Royall located on May Lane.

There being no further business, Council was adjourned.
